The department is seeking highly motivated, team oriented people who possess the ability to handle multiple tasks and have a proven record of leadership.

Minimum qualifications include HS graduation or equivalent, two years of progressive experience with a Public Safety Agency and knowledge of law enforcement practices, technology and methodology. Applicant must be certified or certifiable as a Full-time Police Officer by the New Hampshire Police Standards and Training Council within one-year of appointment.

The application process will include, but is not limited to a written test, physical agility test, extensive background investigation, psychological/polygraph test and medical examination before being appointed. A full job description is available at UNH personnel services.
